

## COLLABORATIVE INSTITUTIONAL TRAINING INITIATIVE (CITI) TRAINING

As standard among Institutional Review Boards in higher education, all principal investigators (PIs) and co-principal investigators (co-PIs) submitting proposals to the HSIRB must complete one of the following training regimens.

- a. Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI) Social-Behavioral-Educational Basic Course
- b. Collaborative Institutional Training Initiative (CITI). CITI Biomedical Basic Course

A complete research proposal submission should include a .pdf copy of the course completion certificate(s) for all PIs and co-PIs. Investigators who completed similar research ethics training programs MAY be excused from completing the CITI training, pending approval from the Moravian College HSIRB Executive Board.

Members of Moravian College's Human Subjects Institutional Review Board are required to complete the CITI Institutional Review Board Members course.
